As per the report received from the Mediation Centre, mediation proceedings have failed.

2. The prayer in the present petition, preferred under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, is for the issuance of a direction to the Family Court, Kharar, SAS Nagar, for expeditious disposal of the petition preferred by the petitioner under Section 13(1) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955.

3. A perusal of the record shows that repeated adjournments have been sought by both sides, including the present petitioner, and evidence has not been led.

4. Learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that the petitioner shall lead evidence in a time bound manner.

5. That being so, the present revision petition is disposed of with a request to the Family Court, Kharar (SAS Nagar) to make concerted efforts for expeditious disposal of the petition preferred by the petitioner as referred to above, provided the petitioner acts diligently and produces his evidence as per the schedule to be fixed by the learned Family Court.
