**LAPITA BANERJI, J. (Oral)**

1. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a Director of Cooperative Bank/respondent No.6. He submits, relying upon the list of elected candidates (Annexure P-1) that they were the persons eligible to elect the office bearers. Alongwith the elected members of the Board of Directors, only 3 candidates nominated by the State Government were eligible to elect the office bearers.

2. He contends that the Managing Director of the Cooperative Bank who is not an elected Director, could not participate in the election of the office bearers, relying on Clause 33 of the Bye-laws for the respondent No.6-Bank.

3. He prays for a decision in his representation dated December 6, 2024 (Annexure P-3) made to the respondent No.3/the Joint Registrar.

4. Issue notice.

5. Mr.Brijesh, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 5. He submits that he has no objection to the representation being decided in a time-bound manner.

6. This Court has heard learned counsel for the parties and directs respondent No.3 to decide the representation of the petitioner within a period of 4 weeks from the date of this order.

7. With the direction aforesaid, CWP-6694-2025 is **disposed of**.

8. Pending application(s), if any, are accordingly, disposed of.
