The prayer in the petition under Section 428 BNSS is for the grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.151 dated 04.07.2025 under Sections 21C/25 NDPS Act (later on added Section 29 of the NDPS Act vide GD No.33 dated 07.07.2025) registered at P.S. Lopoke, District Amritsar Rural.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 31.07.2025, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A short reply dated 10.09.2025 by way of an affidavit of Inderjit Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Rajasansi Amritsar (Rural) has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 31.07.2025 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.

Petition stands disposed of.
