1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 seeking issuance of appropriate direction, with the following substantive prayer:

“It is therefore prayed that the present petition may kindly be allowed, direct the official respondents to consider the case of the petitioner in pursuance of representation dated 05.06.2025 (Annexure P-2) and take appropriate legal action against accused/private respondents who intentionally commit the accident with the intention to kill the petitioner in accordance with law.”

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner limits her prayer and submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, for the *nonce*, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and take a conscious decision on the representation (Annexure P-2) made by the petitioner in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the strength of the advance notice, Mr. Jatinder Pal Singh, Senior DAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents. He

submits he has no objection in case the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, at this stage, is accepted.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the rival parties and have perused the paper-book with their assistance.

6. Keeping in view the entirety of facts and circumstances of the case; without going into merits thereof, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Gurdaspur (respondent No.2 herein) to look into the representation (Annexure P-2) moved by the petitioner; objectively consider the grievance(s) raised in the said representation; take ratiocinated decision thereupon after affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, in accordance with law, within a period of two weeks from today. Such decision be communicated to the petitioner within fifteen days of it being taken.

7. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
