1. This Court, on 11.03.2022, passed the following order: -

“Heard through video conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is working as a Sanitary Inspector in the Municipal Council, Jind. She has barely completed a year at Jind and has been transferred to Safidon to accommodate respondent No.6 who had earlier worked for over eight years at Jind. The transfer is in violation of the instructions dated 13.02.2020 (Annexure P-14) wherein the prescribed tenure is five years but the employee can participate in the transfer drive on completion of three years in his zone. The petitioner is a lady with two minor daughters, one of whom is unwell. He has referred to the medical record at Annexure P-1.

Issue notice to the respondents.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Anant Kataria, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5 and prays for time to file reply.

The operation of the impugned order (Annexure P-12) is stayed till the next date of hearing.”

2. On account of aforesaid order, the petitioner is continuing at Jind. A period of three years from the said date has passed away.
3. Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that as per transfer policy dated 29.04.2022, no employee can stay at a particular place for more than five years and he/she is liable for compulsory transfer through online transfer drive. The petitioner has completed four years at present place of posting and she is bound to be transferred on completion of five years service, as per online transfer policy.
4. In the backdrop, order dated 11.03.2022 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute. The petitioner, as per online transfer policy, would be considered for transfer on completion of five years stay.
5. Disposed of in above terms.
6. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
