1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 483 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant regular bail to him in a case FIR No. 36, dated 23.02.2025, under Sections 109(1), 333, 115(2), 126(2), 351(3), 190,191(3) of B.N.S, Section 117(2) of B.N.S added later on, registered at Police Station Amargarh, District Malerkotla.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the occurrence in the present case had taken place at the spur of the moment and the petitioner has been wrongly named in the FIR. He further contends that as per the prosecution version, the petitioner was armed with a stick, but no overt act has been attributed to him. Even the injured had suffered four injuries and out of the said injuries, only one injury was declared to be grievous in nature, which has been attributed to the main accused. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that in the present case, similarly placed co-accused Lovepreet Singh

and Purbdeep Singh @ Prabhdeep Singh have been granted the concession of interim anticipatory bail by this Court vide order (Annexure P-3). The petitioner is in custody for the last more than 04 months.

3. On the other hand, learned State counsel has vehemently opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner on the ground that two more cases were ordered to be registered against the petitioner.

4. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and perused the record carefully in the present case.

5. In the present case, Pritam Singh had suffered only one grievous injury, which was attributed to Satgur Singh, co-accused. Moreover, two co-accused namely Lovepreet Singh and Purbdeep Singh @ Prabhdeep Singh, who were assigned similar roles, have been granted the concession of interim anticipatory bail by this Court. The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 26.02.2025 and challan has already been presented against him.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate.
