HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner argues the petitioner-Senior Citizen has filed an application under Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007 (hereinafter "2007 Act") which has not been heard as the Coram, as envisaged under the 2007 Act and the Rules framed therein is not complete, which is causing prejudice to the petitioner-Senior Citizen.

2. Mr. Gaurav Jindal, Addl. A.G., Haryana, assisted by Sh. Narender Singh, Supdt., Department of Social Justice and Empowerment, Panipat, submits that the appointments process is going on and out of the total 22 districts, appointments in 11 districts have already been completed. In

District Panipat, the required appointments will also be made, ensuring that the petitioner-Senior Citizen, can avail the benefit of the 2007 Act. These appointments will be made within 4 weeks from the receipt of a copy of this order.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement the learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further at this stage.
