**MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)**

1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 in case FIR No.48, dated 09.02.2025, under Section 15(b) of NDPS Act, 1985 (Section 27-A of NDPS Act added during investigation), registered at Police Station City Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

2. On the last date of hearing i.e. 11.03.2025, while noticing the following submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner and asked him to join investigation:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that although as per the case of the prosecution, secret information was received qua the involvement of the petitioner and his maternal uncle, Bhal Singh, from whom, a recovery of 30.204 kgs of poppy husk was allegedly effected. However,

the secret information qua the involvement of the petitioner in drug trafficking was only on account of the fact that the vehicle in which the alleged contraband was being transported by co-accused, Bhal Singh, was registered in the name of the petitioner.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 11.03.2025, petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions, submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 11.03.2025, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C./482(2) of BNSS, 2023.
