This is a petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a direction to official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner by providing adequate protection to the petitioners and also directing the private respondents not to interfere in the personal life and liberty of the petitioner.

In compliance of order dated 14.11.2024, status report by way of affidavit of Sukhdev Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Sangrur has been filed, the same is taken on record. Copy of the same has been furnished to the counsel opposite.

A perusal of the status report shows that despite efforts being made by Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Sangrur, the petitioners have not turned up for joining the investigate as is evident from enquiry report dated 17.11.2024 annexed as Annexure R-5/T.
