1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of complaint No.COMI-06-2022, dated 19.01.2022 titled as "Gurleen Kaur Vs. Jagjit Singh" pending before the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate SAS Nagar as well as the order dated 18.12.2023 whereby the petitioner had been ordered to be summoned as accused. The aforesaid complaint has been filed by the respondent No.2 making allegations of her being subjected to cruelty at the hands of the petitioner on account of unlawful demand of dowry and being thrown out of her matrimonial house.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties and the complaint which is filed before the concerned trial Court has been withdrawn and accordingly the instant petition has become infructuous..
