**HARKESH MANUJA, J. (Oral)**

1. Learned State counsel on instructions from Sh. Rakesh Kumar, DFO, Amritsar submits that the case of petitioner for regularization has been acceded to and has been forwarded to the office of Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Punjab by the Divisional Forest Officer, Amritsar. He further submits that even the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Punjab shall forward the same to the Government today itself and the necessary benefits in terms of the regularization policy shall be released to the widow of deceased employee within three months from today.
2. In view of the aforesaid undertaking by the respondent(s), learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.
3. Dismissed as not pressed. Rule stands discharged.
4. However, in case the respondent fails to abide by the aforesaid undertaking, his salary to the extent of 1/3<sup>rd</sup> shall remain attached till the compliance is made.
