The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *certiorari* quashing the result dated 18.02.2025, Annexure P-9, whereby the petitioner's candidature for the post of PGT Chemistry, General category in response to advertisement 18 to 37 of 2024, dated 23.07.2024, has been rejected.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case she is permitted to make a fresh representation before the respondents raising the grievance as has been raised in this petition, and the same may be ordered to be decided within a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Tanushree Gupta, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent no.1/State. Mr. Kanwal Goyal, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent no.2/HPSC and submits that in case any such representation is filed by the petitioner within a period of two weeks from today, the same will be decided by the second respondent/Secretary, Haryana Public Service Commission, Panchkula, by passing a speaking order in



accordance with law within a period of eight weeks of receiving the representation.

5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.

6. Ordered accordingly.

7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
