1. By way of filing the present petition, the petitioner has alleged willful disobedience of the order dated 11.08.2016, passed by this Court in CWP-16189-2016 (Annexure P-1), whereby, following directions were passed:-

“xxxxxx

The present petition is disposed of with the directions that the petitioner would not be replaced by another contractual employee.

It is, however, clarified that it would be open for the respondent College to dispense with and to bring to an end contractual engagement of the petitioner in the light of the eventualities that have been noticed and culled out in this order.

In so far as the prayers raised in the petition for grant of minimum scale prescribed by U.G.C is concerned, the issue is left open and liberty is granted to the petitioner to approach respondent authorities in such regard.

2. Compliance report dated 19.09.2025, filed by way of an affidavit of Sh. S. Narayanan, I.F.S., Director General, Higher Education, Haryana, is taken on record. Registry to tag the same at the appropriate place.

2.1. As per the compliance report, the petitioner has been allowed to re-join as Extension Lecturer at Government College, Faridabad, subject to reserving the right of the Department to pass a fresh speaking order regarding her eligibility as per the UGC Regulations. Copy of the letter issued to the petitioner is Annexure R-1 and the joining report of the petitioner is Annexure R-2.

3. In view of the above facts and circumstances, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to challenge the action of the respondents to the extent of “non-payment of wages” for the period she remained out of service, as ordered by the respondent vide Letter dated 29.07.2025 (Annexure R-1).

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.

5. Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
