The instant writ petition has been preferred by the petitioners for seeking quashing of the impugned result/selection/appointment dated 09.10.2024, 03.12.2024 and 05.02.2025 (Annexures P-3, P-4 and P-6) declared pursuant to Advt.No.16/2024 dated 21.06.2024 for the post of Ayurvedic Medical Officer.

2 Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that at this juncture the petitioners would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondent No.4-Haryana Public Service Commission, Panchkula, to decide the claim raised by the petitioner in the representation dated 26.02.2025

3 Notice of motion.

4 Ms. Tanisha Peshawaria, DAG, Haryana. enters appearance and accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and Mr. Balwinder Sangwan, Advocate, enters appearance on behalf of respondent No.4-HPSC. They submit that they have no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

5 Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.4-Haryana Public Service Commission, Panchkula, , to decide the claim raised by the petitioner in the present writ petition by treating the same as a representation and to pass a speaking and reasoned order thereupon in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and a copy of present petition along with accompanying Annexures, after granting an opportunity of hearing to the petitioners if prescribed under rules/law.
