1. Present civil revision petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the impugned order dated 09.04.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Additional District Judge, Ambala.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that against the judgment and decree dated 27.02.2025 (Annexure P-3), an appeal has been filed by the present petitioner, which is listed for final arguments on 06.10.2025 before the 1st Appellate Court. It is further submitted that there is urgency in the matter, inasmuch as, the electricity connection of the present petitioner has been removed and he is living without any electricity. It is stated that in the said circumstances, the petitioner would

be satisfied in case the 1st Appellate Court is directed to decide the said appeal in a time bound manner. It is further stated that counsel for the petitioner would be ready to argue the appeal on 06.10.2025 or any other date which the Appellate Authority directs the counsel to argue.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent has no objection to the said course of action.

4. Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances and the fair stand taken on behalf of learned counsel for the petitioner as well as on behalf of the respondent and in view of the urgency in the matter, the present revision petition is disposed of with a request to the 1st Appellate Court to decide the said appeal i.e. CA/133/2025, which is stated to be listed for hearing on 06.10.2025, as expeditiously as possible, preferably, within a period of four months from 06.10.2025.

5. As undertaken before this Court, counsel for all the parties concerned appearing before the 1st Appellate Court would fully prepare the case and argue the matter on 06.10.2025 or at any other date as given by the 1st Appellate Court.
