Application for condonation of delay of 104 days in filing of appeal is allowed, and accordingly delay is condoned.

Main case

1. The appellant has preferred this LPA assailing the interim order dated 19.07.2024 in CWP-29545-2023 passed by learned Single Judge, whereby it has been directed to stay the appointment of the appellant and disallow in making any payments to her.
2. Learned counsel submits that the order has been passed *ex parte*, and he has already moved an application for vacation of stay of the said order, which is pending.

3. Provisions of Article 226(3) of the Constitution of India are mandatory and are required to be followed.
4. In view thereto, we hope that the Hon'ble Single Judge would pass appropriate orders on the application filed under Article 226(3).
5. It is also informed that the case is already listed on 20.01.2025. No interference is therefore warranted.
6. With the said observations, the LPA is dismissed, leaving it open for the Hon'ble Single Judge to pass appropriate orders.
