**VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)**

1. Present Contempt Petition has been filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Section 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for violating and disobeying the order dated 13.11.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court.

Learned State counsel has submitted that in compliance to the judgment dated 13.11.2024 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, a speaking order dated 21.05.2025 has been passed, a copy of which is taken on record as Mark-A. Copy of the same has been handed over to the learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he is not fully satisfied with the said speaking order and thus, prays that the present petition may be disposed of with the liberty to the petitioner to challenge the said speaking order, in accordance with law.
