Prayer in this petition is for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent for not complying the order dated 04.8.2023 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-4526 of 2019 titled as "Rakesh and others vs. Haryana Staff Selection Commission" whereby the petition was disposed of in terms of order of even date passed in CWP No.1285 of 2019 titled as "Manoj Kumar vs. Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula" vide which the writ petition was disposed of on the basis of statement made by learned counsel for the State to the effect that "*....in case any representation is filed by the petitioners, the same will be considered in accordance with law and an appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of*



any such representation and after passing of the order, in case any benefit is to be extended to the petitioners, the same will also be extended to them within a further period of four weeks.”

Learned counsel for the respondent-State refers to the reply dated 14.6.2024 filed by way of affidavit of Shri Vinay Kumar, IRPS, Secretary Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula to submit that in compliance of the order dated 04.8.2023 (Annexure P-1) a Speaking Order dated 13.03.2024/01.4.2024 (Annexure R-1) has been passed rejecting the claim of the petitioner; thus, no cause survives in the present petition.

Heard.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the respondent-State, the present petition is being **disposed of**.

Needless to say, the petitioner shall be at liberty to challenge the Speaking Order dated 13.03.2024/01.4.2024 (Annexure R-1) in accordance with law, if so advised.

Rule stands discharged.

Pending application(s), if any, shall stands disposed of.
