1. Aforesaid case was filed by Sh. Ravinder Singh, Advocate on 14.10.2024 and Registry raised objection on 15.10.2024, which were not removed by learned counsel.

2. As per Rule 9, Chapter 1, Part-A, Volume V, Punjab and Haryana High Court Rules and Orders, the petition on which objection has been raised by the Registry is to be taken back by counsel/party concerned who filed it, to be re-filed within a period of 40 days. The file in hand was never taken back for re-filing after removal of objections despite note published by Registry time and again and despite sending SMS at the registered mobile numbers of Advocate(s)/their Clerk(s)/litigant.

3. Even today, nobody has turned up on behalf of petitioner.

4. Considering the aforesaid factual position, it appears that learned counsel who had filed present case is not interested to pursue the same. Therefore, it stands disposed off for want of prosecution.
