

caused injuries to him, which is evident from the medico-legally report of Ranjodh Singh (Annexure P-3). Due to the said enmity, the police has planted the present case against the petitioner in collusion with the opposite side. He further contends that the recovery in the present case has already been effected and the custodial interrogation of the petitioner may not be required.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has reiterated the submissions and further submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation may not be required.

4. On the other hand, learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

5. In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the interim order dated 09.04.2025 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S.
