1. This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.91 dated 11.11.2021, under Sections 336, 506, 201, 430, 34 IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Dera Baba Nanak, District Gurdaspur (Annexure P-1) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise deed dated 07.11.2024 (Annexure P-2).

2. A Coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 22.11.2024 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua the genuineness of the compromise.

3. Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties have appeared before the learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division)-cum-Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Batala and got their statements recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned Magistrate has submitted copy of report dated 09.04.2025 to the effect that the compromise has been effected between the parties voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.

4. Learned State counsel as well as counsel for respondent No.2 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

5. In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant FIR.

6. Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052** and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303**, this petition is allowed and FIR No.91 dated 11.11.2021, under Sections 336, 506, 201, 430, 34 IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Dera Baba Nanak, District Gurdaspur and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) are quashed qua the petitioners.
