1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner for directions to transfer the investigation to a superior police official.
2. Notice of motion to the respondents No.1 to 5 only.
3. Mr. Eklavya Darshi, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 5, and waives service.

The learned counsel representing the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has moved the representation dated 01.04.2025 (Annexure P-4) seeking for transfer of investigation, and also for deputing a senior Police Officer as Investigating Officer. He has submitted that direction to respondent No.2 may be issued to dispose of the representation (Annexure



P-4) moved by the petitioner, and the instant petition may be disposed of, accordingly.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present writ petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the DGP, Punjab, to decide the representation (Annexure P-4) by passing a speaking order, moved by the petitioner, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of copy of instant order.
