The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.20, dated 09.08.2023, registered under Sections 409,418,420,467,468,471,120-B of IPC and Sections 13(1)(c) and 13(1)(d) of Prevention of Corruption Actr at Police Station ACB Hisar.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 26.02.2024 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
3. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
4. In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the interim order dated 26.02.2024 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under
