VIKRAM AGGARWAL, J. (Oral):

1. The present revision petition assails the order dated 22.05.2024, vide which objections filed by respondents No.2 and 3 were partly allowed and it was ordered that draft sale deed for 10 marla of land instead of 8 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> marla be filed.
2. As per the status obtained from the website, the execution petition itself stands withdrawn on 05.05.2025;

*“Today the case came up for awaiting execution of warrants of possession of the property. At this stage, decree-holder vide his separate statement stated that he has received the possession of 10 marla land from the judgment-debtor and & for remaining land separate proceedings are going on. So, he does not want to pursue further with the present execution petition and withdrew the same. Heard & perused the records. In view of the statement of decree-holder, the execution petition is hereby dismissed as withdrawn. File be consigned to the Judicial Records room, Charkhi Dadri after due*



*compliance.”*

3. That being so, the present revision petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.
