The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner for quashing the order dated 19.02.2025 (Annexure P-4) passed by the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana in case arising out of FIR No.126 dated 28.07.2020 registered under Section 15 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 Act, at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, Police Commissionerate Ludhiana whereby his bail was cancelled and bonds were forfeited to the State due to his non-appearance on that particular date and non-bailable warrants were ordered to be issued against him for 07.03.2025.

2. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that due to some misunderstanding he had noted the next date of hearing as 22.02.2025 instead of 19.02.2025 and due to that reason, he could not appear before the learned trial Court on 19.02.2025. His absence was not intentional. He is ready to join the proceedings before the trial Court and to abide by the terms and



conditions to be imposed upon him, therefore, prayer has been made for allowing the present petition.

3. Though, no justification has been made out for setting aside the impugned orders as no illegality seems to have been committed by learned trial Court while passing the same, however, in view of the request made by learned counsel for the petitioner at this stage to grant the petitioner one more opportunity to surrender before the trial Court and further keeping in view the fact that the absence of the petitioner does not attract the consequences of detaining him into custody as he is willing to join the trial and the ultimate aim is to ensure timely disposal of the cases before the learned trial Court, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court on or before 07.03.2025 and it is further ordered that on his surrender and on moving appropriate application, the learned trial Court admit him to bail subject to deposit of Rs.5,000/- with DLSA, Ludhiana and further subject to his furnishing personal as well as surety bonds to its satisfaction. However, this petition shall be deemed to be dismissed if the petitioner does not abide by this order.

Petition stands disposed of.

A copy of this order be sent to the trial Court.
