1. This is a Civil Revision Petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 06.10.2023 (Annexure P-4) vide which during the pendency of the appeal, the application for grant of stay of operation of the judgment and decree of the trial Court has been dismissed.

2. On 20.10.2023, a Coordinate Bench of this Court was pleased to pass the following order:-

3. During the course of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the respondent have, on instructions from their respective clients, reached a consensus. On the basis of the consensus of the learned counsel for the parties, the present revision petition is disposed of in the following terms:-

i) The Ist Appellate Court, before whom the appeal filed by the present petitioner against the judgment and decree dated 14.11.2022 is pending i.e., Civil Appeal no.8 of 2023, is requested to decide the same as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of 3 months from the date of the next date of hearing. Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the respondent have undertaken before this Court that the counsel would fully assist the Ist Appellate Court in expeditious disposal of the appeal.

ii) The interim order dated 20.10.2023 would continue till the date the appeal is decided. The grant and continuation of the said order would not be construed as an expression on the merits of the case and the Ist Appellate court would decide the appeal independently, in accordance with law after taking into consideration the entire evidence and documents on records.
