1. This appeal has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the appellant in case bearing FIR No. 306 dated 28.07.2023 under Sections 147/148/149/323/342/365/377/506 IPC and Section 3(1)(r)(s)/(3)(va) of SC/ST Act, 1989, registered at Police Station Sadar Dabwali.

2. Vide order dated 20.05.2024, while granting interim protection, the appellant was directed to join the investigation.

3. Learned counsel for the appellant has submitted that pursuant to order dated 20.05.2024, appellant has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions, affirmed that the appellant has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

5. In view of the above, interim order dated 20.05.2024, is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023
