1. Through the instant petition, cast under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus upon the respondents No.1 to 3, to take appropriate legal and disciplinary action against the private respondent No.4-Principal, Govt. Adarsh Senior Secondary School, Lodhipur (Anandpur Sahib), Tehsil Anandpur Sahib, District Rupnagar, for his alleged acts of misconduct, for tampering and fabricating the official records.

2. What surfaced from the perusal of the written statement filed on behalf of the respondents-State of Punjab is that, the enquiry has been initiated in this matter, and the Enquiry Officer concluded that the allegations made by the petitioner were baseless and unfounded.

3. The competent authority concerned, has also agreed with the enquiry report, and the complaint was ordered to be filed.

4. In view of the supervening events, the prayer made in the instant writ petition has been rendered infructuous. However, in case, the petitioner still has any grievance, he is at liberty to challenge the enquiry report, before the apt authorities concerned.

5. Consequently, the instant writ petition is **disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.**
