By way of the present writ petition, the petitioner has sought issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to restore the electricity and water supply connections in the property of the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already made representations dated 06.12.2024 and 16.01.2025 (Annexures P-4 and P-5) to the Director/Manager, Landmark Apartment Pvt. Ltd., New Delhi and the Manager, Bank of India, Karsan Road, Manesar, Gurugram, Haryana, for redressal of his grievances, but no action has been taken thereon till date. He further submits that the petitioners would be satisfied, if the respondent authorities are directed to deal with his concerns/grievances and pass appropriate order on the said representation(s).

3. Served with the advance copy of the petition, Mr. Vinish Singla, Advocate, appears on behalf of respondent No.1-Bank and submits that the said representation/application shall be considered and decided in accordance with law.

4. Without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1-General Manager, Bank of India to look into the pending representation dated 16.01.2025 (Annexure P-5) and pass an appropriate reasoned order thereon, in accordance with law, preferably within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy/production of this order.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
