1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Sections 10 & 12 read with Section 2(b) of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiating contempt proceedings against respondent for non-compliance of order dated 24.02.2021 (Annexure P-2) passed by this court in CWP-3732-2021.

2. In compliance of order dated 24.02.2021 (Annexure P-2) passed by this court in CWP-3732-2021, the counsel for the respondent-State has placed on record copy of affidavit filed on behalf of respondent dated 21.02.2024, which is taken on record.

3. The counsel for the respondent-State, after going through the aforesaid affidavit, has submitted that the order qua which contempt was asserted, has since been complied with. No further action is required in the matter. Accordingly, the present petition has been rendered as infructuous.

4. Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unaddressed, the petitioner will be at liberty to avail any other remedy, but in accordance with law.
