1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 483 of BNSS for grant of interim bail to him for 06 weeks (for the medical treatment of his wife namely Bimlesh) in case bearing FIR No.286 dated 09.06.2022 under Sections 20/61 and 85 of NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Hodel, District Palwal, Haryana.
2. On instructions, State counsel submits that the petitioner has a son aged 24 years and two daughters and one of those is adult and married.
3. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner's son is not in town.
4. Be that as it may, it is not the duty of son alone to take care of his mother but the daughters are equally responsible to look after their mother even if one of those is married. Given above, no case for interim bail is made out for the reasons that there are two adult children and one daughter, who minor but not a kid.
5. Given above, the present petition stands dismissed. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to file a petition on merits. All the applications, if any, stand disposed of.
