The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under section 483 of BNSS, 2023 read with section 528 BNSS,2023, for grant of interim regular bail to the petitioner/ accused in case FIR No.21 dated 19.02.2025 Under Sections: 341(3), 197, 316(5), 318, 320, 323 and 61(2) (added later on) of the BNS, 2023 Police Station Sector-11, U.T. Chandigarh

The petitioner has requested interim bail to attend to the treatment and care of his pregnant wife, who is in the final and critical stage of a twin pregnancy.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sumit Jain, APP UT. Chandigarh has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-U.T. Chandigarh and filed a short reply way of an affidavit of Mr. Dhiraj Kumar, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Crime Branch, Chandigarh, which is taken on record.

The counsel for the respondent-UT. Chandigarh submits that, according to the medical records obtained from the concerned hospital, the petitioner's wife is expecting twins, and the due date of delivery is between 19.08.2025 and 22.08.2025.

In the light of above exceptional circumstances, the petitioner is directed to be released on interim bail commencing from today i.e., 18.08.2025 on furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

The petitioner shall surrender back to the Jail authorities on 31.08.2025 by 5 PM.

The petition stands disposed off, in the aforesaid terms.
