**SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)**

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks and is permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to avail the permissible legal remedy, through a civil suit in respect of the subject claim, being raised before the Civil Court of competent jurisdiction. The said suit be filed within a period of 07 days from today and till the filing of the said suit, the parties are directed to maintain status quo with respect of the subject chamber. However, subsequently, on an application cast under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 CPC being instituted in the civil suit, thereupons, the learned Civil Court of competent jurisdiction, may proceed to either extend or not to extend the order of status quo, which has been passed today and whose life



would last only upto the filing of the civil suit, thus, within a week from today.
