1. Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 19.12.2016, in CWP No. 26281-2016, in case titled as Ramesh Chander vs. State of Punjab and others.

2. A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No. 26281-2016, was disposed of by granting opportunity to the petitioner to move a representation / legal notice and the same to be considered and decided at an early date by taking appropriate action in accordance with law.

3. Affidavit of Sh. Navjot Pal Singh Randhawa, Deputy Commissioner, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar, dated 16.09.2022, has been filed by learned State Counsel in court today. The same is taken on record and copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. A perusal of Annexure R-7/T attached to the reply reveals that pursuant to receipt of representation by the petitioner, the Field Book and Musawi pertaining to Hadbast No. 126, Village Nawanshahar, was reconstructed.

5. Learned Counsel for the petitioner states that in the circumstances, the petitioner is satisfied with the action taken, therefore, does not press the instant petition and may be allowed to withdraw the same.

6. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
