1. The petitioner has filed the present contempt petition under Sections 12 and 14 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for non-compliance of order dated 24.03.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-37555-2018 titled as 'Jatinderpal Singh vs. The Tribunal under Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens, Karnal and others'.

2. At the very outset, it is admitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that in compliance of the order dated 24.03.2025 (Annexure P-1) payment of ₹1,60,000/- due to the petitioner has been made by the respondents to the petitioner. Therefore, learned counsel submits that nothing survives in the present petition and the same may be disposed of.

3. In view of the above, the present petition is **disposed of**, accordingly.
