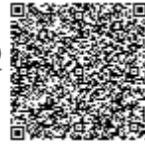

1. Instant revision petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of an appropriate order to the appellate Court for decision of appeal bearing No. CMA/49/2023, titled as ***Lakhvir Singh @ Kulvir Singh Vs. Santosh Kaur @ Ravinder Kaur and others.***

2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had filed a suit for declaration to the effect that he is owner in possession of the suit property and along with an application under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 of Code of Civil Procedure, 1908. He submits that after being served, defendants filed separate written statements contesting the suit and by order dated 20.07.2023, Annexure P-4, trial Court disposed off the application by directing the parties to maintain status quo in the main suit as well as in the counter claim. Counsel states that this order has

been challenged by the petitioner by filing an appeal, Annexure P-5, which is pending since August, 2023. He requests that a direction be issued to the appellate Court to decide the appeal in a time bound manner.

3. Having heard counsel for the petitioner, this Court is of the view that although, no case is made out for giving a direction to the appellate Court to decide the appeal within a specific time frame as the appeal is of the year 2023, however, considering the fact that the appeal is against an interim order, appellate Court shall make an endeavour and adjudicate it as expeditiously as possible.

4. Petition is disposed off.

5. As the main petition has been decided, all pending applications shall stand disposed off.
