1. Present civil writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the official respondents to release the periodic enhanced arrears of old age pension by calculating the additional quantum of pension/family pension, in view of the Finance Circular dated 12.03.2012 (Annexure P-3), adopted by the respondent-PSPCL, as pension is enhanced after every 05 years, which is further revised vide Finance Circulars dated 17.11.2021 (Annexures P-4 & P-5) and is implemented from the year 2016.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that at this stage, the petitioners would be satisfied, if the representation dated 13.06.2024



(Annexure P-10) is decided by respondents No.1 & 4, by passing a speaking order, after affording an opportunity of hearing, in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Kamaldeep Kaur, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-PSPCL and she has no objection, in case a direction is issued to respondents No.1 & 4 to consider and decide the representation dated 13.06.2024 (Annexure P-10), in a time bound manner, by passing a speaking order.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners, present petition is disposed of and respondents No.1 & 4 are directed to consider and decide the representation dated 13.06.2024 (Annexure P-10) and pass a speaking order, after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioners, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

6. Further, the decision taken on the representation dated 13.06.2024 (Annexure P-10) shall be conveyed to the petitioners.

7. Needless to say, if the petitioners are found entitled to the relief sought, the same be granted to them forthwith by the competent authority.
