1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 17.12.2021 passed in CWP-25750-2021.

2. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 17.12.2021 passed in CWP-25750-2021 has been complied with. Reply by way of affidavit of Shatrujeet Kapur, Director General of Police, Haryana, Panchkula, has been produced by the counsel for the respondent in the Court today. The same is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.

3. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.



4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
