Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.203 dated 16.9.2024 registered under Sections 115(2), 118(1), 351, 191(3), 190, 304(2) of BNS at Police Station Kotwali, District Patiala.

2. On the last date of hearing, the petitioner was granted interim bail with direction to join investigation with the police.

3. Today, counsel for the petitioner made statement that in pursuance of the aforesaid interim order of bail, the petitioner has joined investigation with the police.
