1. Short reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Kamal Kishor Yadav, Secretary to the Government of Punjab, Department of School Education, Chandigarh has been filed in Court, the same is taken on record.
2. Learned State counsel representing the respondent on instructions from Mr. Shashi Gagg, Asstt. Registrar (Legal) office of D.S.E. (SE) S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali) informs that arrears amounting to Rs.8,51,304/- shall be released in favour of the petitioner within four weeks from today.
3. In view of the aforesaid undertaking by the respondent(s), learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.
4. Dismissed as not pressed. Rule stands discharged.
5. However, in case the needful is not done within the aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- as cost(s) from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
