1. The present petition is for quashing of order dated 20.12.2024 (Annexure P-3) in case FIR No.27 dated 21.01.2019, under Sections 406, 498-A of IPC, registered at Police Station Women Police Station, District Chandigarh (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel appearing for the State has pointed out that the petitioner did not comply with the order dated 24.01.2025 and subsequently, the petitioner was arrested on 16.08.2025, however, later on, petitioner was released on bail on 19.08.2025. Hence, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and no further orders are required to be passed.
