Prayer in this petition is for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents for not complying the order dated 07.8.2023 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-798-2020 titled as "Shri Ram Chopra vs. State of Haryana and others" whereby the petition was disposed of with the following observation/direction :-

"xxx xxx xxx

*Consequently, the present writ petition is allowed. The sanction of the part medical expenses incurred is set aside and the petitioner will be entitled for the full reimbursement of the implant done @ Rs.5,42,200/-rather than on the ceiling of Rs.3 lacs fixed by the respondents. The respondents are directed to reimburse the full*



*amount for which the petitioner has submitted the bills i.e. Rs.5,95,500/- with a period of two months from the receipt of certified copy of this order as no dispute has been raised qua the spending of the said amount on the medical treatment by the petitioner. Amount already paid to the petitioner should be adjusted.”*

Learned counsel for the respondents-State refers to the Affidavit dated 11.12.2023 of Mrs. Ashima Brar, Director General Secondary Education Haryana, Panchkula on behalf of respondent No.1, filed in the Registry, which has been annexed on the file, to submit that the entire payment of Rs.5,95,500/- stands paid to the petitioner vide Sanction Order dated 08.11.2023 (Annexure R-1) wherein it is noted that an amount of Rs.3,53,300/- already stands paid to the petitioner vide sanction issued Memo No.8/187-2018 HRG-I(5) dated 15.12.2018; and the remaining payment of Rs.2,42,200/- stood sanctioned vide order dated 15.12.2018 (Annexure R-2), pursuant to which Pay Order dated 16.12.2023 (Annexure R-3) for the said amount of Rs.2,42,200/- has been issued. It is also pointed out that no replication to this affidavit dated 11.12.2023 filed by the respondent, has been filed by the petitioner. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that thus, no cause survives in the present petition.

Heard.

Today none has put in appearance on behalf of petitioner.

However, in view of the facts noted above and the submissions made on behalf of learned counsel for the respondents-



State, the present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is hereby **disposed of** accordingly.

Rule stands discharged.
