Learned counsel further contends that Richpal, who was apprehended red handed by the police, has been granted the concession of bail vide order dated 24.12.2024 (Annexure P-3) by the trial Court. He further contends that the other co-accused, namely, Nar Singh has been granted the concession of interim anticipatory bail by this Court. The petitioner was arrested in the present case on 18.02.2025 and is in custody for the last about 05 months. After the presentation of challan, the trial has not progressed and even charge has not been framed against the petitioner. He further contends that there is no other criminal case against the petitioner.

3. On the other hand, learned State counsel, assisted by learned counsel for the complainant have vehemently opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner on the ground that the petitioner is involved in a serious crime.

4. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

5. In the present case, the petitioner is stated to be in custody for the last more than 05 months and the challan has already been presented against him. Even the main accused, Richpal Singh has already been granted the concession of bail vide order dated 24.12.2024 (Annexure P-3).

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate, concerned.
