SUDEEPTI SHARMA J. (Oral)

1. The present contempt petition has been filed for willful and intentional disobedience of order dated 07.12.2022, passed by this Court in CWP-8941-2022 titled as "***Sukhjinder Singh & others Vs. State of Punjab and others***".

2. Learned counsel for the respondents contend that CWP-8941-2022 alongwith four other connected writ petitions were taken up together and disposed of vide order dated 14.05.2025.



3. Thereafter, respondent Nos.4 & 5 filed a review against order dated 14.05.2025, which was allowed vide order dated 22.08.2025 and the writ petitions are restored to original number and would be now decided afresh.

4. In view of the same, since order dated 07.12.2022 for disobedience of which the present contempt petition is filed has now been reviewed. Therefore, the present contempt petition is dismissed.
