1. Present petition has been filed praying for directing respondents No.1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner which is endangered at the behest of private respondents No.5 to 7 as the petitioner is victim of the attack conducted by the private respondents near the residential house of petitioner and the concerned SHO and Investigating Officer are bent upon to help and aid the private respondents with their act and conduct (as elaborated in the body of the petition), whereas private respondents No.5 to 7 are roaming freely in the vicinity of the village while hurling threats and abuses to the petitioners and their families. Further prayer has been made for directing respondents No.1 to 4 to take appropriate legal action against respondents No.5 to 7 for threatening the petitioner and their families and for taking legal action on the applications dated 22.07.2025



(Annexures P-3 & P-4) submitted by the petitioner in accordance with law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Lalita Kumari vs. Govt. of U.P.', (SC) 2013(4) RCR (Criminal) 979.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner has already filed his application/representation dated 22.07.2025 (Annexure P-3) before respondent No.2 & 3, but no action has been taken on the same till date.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents at this stage.

4. On asking of the Court, Ms. Simran Gorla, Asstt. A.G., Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4-State. He submits that application/representation filed by the petitioner dated 22.07.2025 (Annexure P-3) would be decided expeditiously in accordance with law.

5. In view of the above position, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3, i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Khanna, Punjab to look into the application/representation of the petitioner dated 22.07.2025 (Annexure P-3) and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of the order.
