HARKESH MANUJA, J. (Oral)

1. Learned State counsel submits that an Intra-Court Appeal bearing LPA No.58 of 2025 against the order passed by the Writ Court was listed today, though the same has been dismissed, yet the respondents have been granted three weeks' time for compliance of the order passed by the Writ Court and the same shall be positively done with the stipulated time.
2. In view of aforesaid stand taken by the respondents, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.
3. Dismissed as not pressed. Rule stands discharged.
4. However, in case the needful is not done within the aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- as cost(s) from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
