This petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for directing the official respondents to decide the representation (Annexure P-3) filed by the petitioner No. 1 and his family members wherein official respondents are harassing the petitioner No. 1 by calling him at the police station and by giving him beatings because allegedly the elder son of the petitioner No. 1 had ran away with some unknown girl despite being married and the wife of son of the petitioner had allegedly filed a complaint before the police because of which the petitioners are being brutally harassed.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied, in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2-the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to decide the representation dated 06.01.2025 (Annexure P-3) within a time bound manner.



3. Without advertng to the merits of the case, the respondent No.2- the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 06.01.2025 (Annexure P-3) by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. A copy of order so passed be supplied to the petitioner within one week thereafter.

5. Petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
