1. Appeal is against order passed by Commissioner under the Workmen's Compensation Act dated 26.04.1999 whereby respondent has been awarded compensation of Rs.49,915/-.
2. The employment has not denied. It is also not denied that the claimant suffered injury while riding one of the horses. The only issue raised is that the claimant was riding horse namely, Toofan without taking necessary precaution and without prior permission of the higher authorities.
3. Counsel for the appellant has not been able to point out any evidence brought on record by the appellant with respect to prior permission required under the rules or the safety equipment being supplied to the workers working on the farm.
4. In view thereof, this Court does not find any reason to interfere in the present appeal and the same is ordered to be dismissed.
