This petition has been filed under Section 528 of BNSS seeking directions to respondents No. 2 & 4 to conduct a fair and impartial enquiry in the case of FIR No. 0151, dated 01.07.2025 (Annexure P-1), under sections 126(2), 115(2), 191(3), 190 of BNS registered at Police Station City Rajpura, District Patiala and to complete the investigation expeditiously.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied, in case a direction is issued to respondent No.3-the Senior Superintendent of Police, Mini Secretariat, Nabha Road, Patiala, Punjab to decide the representation dated 14.07.2025 (Annexure P-6) within a time bound manner.

3. Without adverting to the merits of the case, the respondent No.3-the Senior Superintendent of Police, Mini Secretariat, Nabha Road, Patiala, Punjab is

directed to consider and decide the representation dated 14.07.2025 (Annexure P-6), after providing opportunity of hearing to the parties, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. A copy of order so passed be supplied to the petitioner within seven days thereafter.

5. Petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
