Challenge in the present writ petition is to the chargesheet dated 07.06.2024 (Annexure P-2); proceedings dated 12.06.2024 (Annexure P-3); order dated 12.06.2024 (Annexure P-4) and order dated 27.05.2025 (Annexure P-7) whereby the petitioner has been dismissed from service alleging the same to be illegal and arbitrary.

At the very outset, counsel appearing for the petitioner contends that certain incomplete and incorrect documents have been appended with the present writ petition and therefore, he seeks withdrawal of the same with liberty to file a fresh petition on the same cause of action but with better and complete particulars.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents has no objection to the same.
